Jason Alexander Found Guilty of Trespass and Battery

VENTURA, California - District Attorney Erik Nasarenko announced today that Jason Alexander (DOB 10/16/81), of Kentwood, Louisiana, was found guilty of aggravated trespass and battery after entering pleas of no contest to these misdemeanor offenses.

On June 9, 2022, Ventura County Sheriff's Office deputies responded to the residence of Britney Spears after Alexander gained uninvited access to her property and entered her home on her wedding day. Alexander damaged a door and battered a security guard who attempted to remove him from the residence after he refused to comply with verbal commands to leave the premises.

Alexander was sentenced to credit for time served after spending 64 days in the Ventura County Jail. As a result of the plea, a criminal protective order was issued prohibiting Alexander from coming within 100 yards of both victims.
