Fourth Memorial Observance of Borderline Bar & Grill Shooting

VENTURA, Calif. - District Attorney Erik Nasarenko announced today that November 7, 2022, marks the fourth anniversary of the Borderline Bar and Grill shooting, where 12 lives were taken including that of on-duty Ventura County Sheriff's Office Sergeant Ron Helus.

In honor of the four-year observance, Give an Hour, a national nonprofit that specializes in mental health and emotional wellness, in partnership with the Ventura County District Attorney's Office, and the Ventura County Family Justice Center, invites families, survivors, first responders, and community members to gather on Monday, November 7, 2022, from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the Borderline Healing Garden at Conejo Creek North Park in Thousand Oaks.

Victim Advocates and Courthouse Facility Dogs, Star, Comet, and Trakr from the Ventura County District Attorney's Office, Crime Victims' Assistance Unit will join Give an Hour staff, and clinicians at the Borderline Healing Garden to remember the lives taken and support one another.

Thousand Oaks City Hall will be lit up in green on the nights of November 6, 2022 through November 12, 2022, in honor of the November 7th, Day of Remembrance.

Help is still available for those present at the Borderline shooting, including no cost support groups through Give an Hour, as well as reimbursements through the California Victim Compensation Board (CalVCB) for medical bills, mental health treatment, income loss and more.
