Convicted Child Molester Sentenced to 610 Years Case: 2021029627

VENTURA, Calif. - District Attorney Erik Nasarenko announced today that convicted child sex offender, Travis Edward Martin (DOB 06/08/85), of Santa Paula, was sentenced to 610 years to life in prison.

The sentence was handed down by Ventura County Superior Court Judge David Worley on November 8, 2022.

Martin, a previously convicted child molester, repeatedly molested a child who was between the ages of 4 to 6 years old. The charged crimes occurred in both Ventura County and Orange County between 2019 and 2021.

"We are pleased with the jury's verdict and the judge's sentence in this case, which accurately reflects the harm caused by the defendant's horrific crimes," said Supervising Deputy District Attorney Rafael Orellana, who prosecuted the case. "The 610 years to life sentence will serve to protect our community and demonstrates that there is zero tolerance for the sexual abuse and exploitation of children."

Martin was charged and convicted of lewd or lascivious acts with a child, using a child for production of pornography and possession of child pornography. A Ventura County jury found him guilty on all counts and special allegations on October 3, 2022.
