## Convicted Sex Offender Charged with Assault on Oxnard Police Officer

VENTURA, Calif. – District Attorney Erik Nasarenko announced today that Lucio Sedeno (DOB 11/12/90), of Oxnard, has been charged with assault on a peace officer, resisting a peace officer causing serious bodily injury, and failure to update his annual sex offender registration. Sedeno also faces two special allegations, including causing great bodily injury in commission of a felony.

On April 7, 2025, Oxnard Police Department officers responded to a family dispute. Upon arrival, officers learned that Sedeno had allegedly assaulted a family member and was out of compliance with sex offender registration requirements. Sedeno refused to comply with directions from officers and started walking away. Officer followed and attempted to take Sedeno into custody. He is charged with using a large shard of glass and slashing one of the officers in the side of the neck.

Sedeno was ultimately taken into custody without further incident. The injured officer was treated at a local hospital.

"This case underscores the dangers our law enforcement officers face in the line of duty," said District Attorney Erik Nasarenko. "We will vigorously prosecute those who threaten our public safety officers and cause harm to members of our community."

Deputy District Attorney Celeste Sanchez, a member of the Ventura County District Attorney's Office Crimes Against Police Officers Unit, is prosecuting the case.

Sedeno made his first court appearance on April 9, 2025, where he pled not guilty to all charges. An early disposition conference is scheduled for April 18, 2025, at 1:30 p.m. in courtroom 12 of the Ventura County Superior Court. Sedeno remains in custody with bail set at \$80,000.
