Oak Park Man Charged with Gross Vehicular Manslaughter in Deadly Newbury Park Crash

VENTURA, Calif. – Ventura County District Attorney Erik Nasarenko announced today that Neil Liam Reb (DOB 11/07/03), of Oak Park, has been charged with two counts of felony gross vehicular manslaughter in connection with the deaths of Alejandro and Maria Ramirez. Reb also faces a special allegation that the crime is a serious felony.

On May 6, 2025, at approximately 4:00 p.m., Reb was driving a 2024 Jeep Wrangler when he collided with a Volkswagen Tiguan at the intersection of Via Las Brisas and Calle Del Prado in Newbury Park. The crash resulted in the deaths of Mr. and Mrs. Ramirez. Investigators allege Reb was driving recklessly, traveling at nearly twice the posted speed limit of 45 mph.

Reb was arrested on June 30, 2025, after an investigation by the Ventura County Sheriff's Office. He is scheduled to be arraigned on July 14, 2025, at 8:15 a.m. in Ventura County Superior Court. Reb is out of custody after posting \$50,000 bail.
